

## Trip Plan – Harts Range Bush Sports and Tower Rock – 4-6 August 2017

Saturday 5 August 2017	08.00 – Meet at Hungry Jacks for a 08.30 start 08.30 – Depart Alice Springs to Harts Range (215 km drive) 10.30 – Arrive Harts Range Races 13.00 – Rodeo events 19.00 – Black tie ball – Dance Hall – for interested
Sunday 6 August 2017	09.30 – Rodeo events 13.00 – Depart Harts Range to Tower Rock (105 km drive)
Monday 7 August 2017	09.00 – Depart Tower Rock to Mount Swan (27 km drive) and then drive back to Alice Springs (283 km drive). May stop at Gemtree for a snack/lunch/icecream along the way.

**Track conditions:** Mostly sealed roads with some gravel road driving (Plenty Highway). The track to Tower Rock and Mt Swan is unsealed and a 4WD is recommended.

**Cost:** Weekend pass \$40 per adult, including camping or \$20 for day ticket. Children <16 yrs free. Dance Admission is \$5 per person (under 16 free). Men are required to wear a tie.

### Don't Forget to Bring:

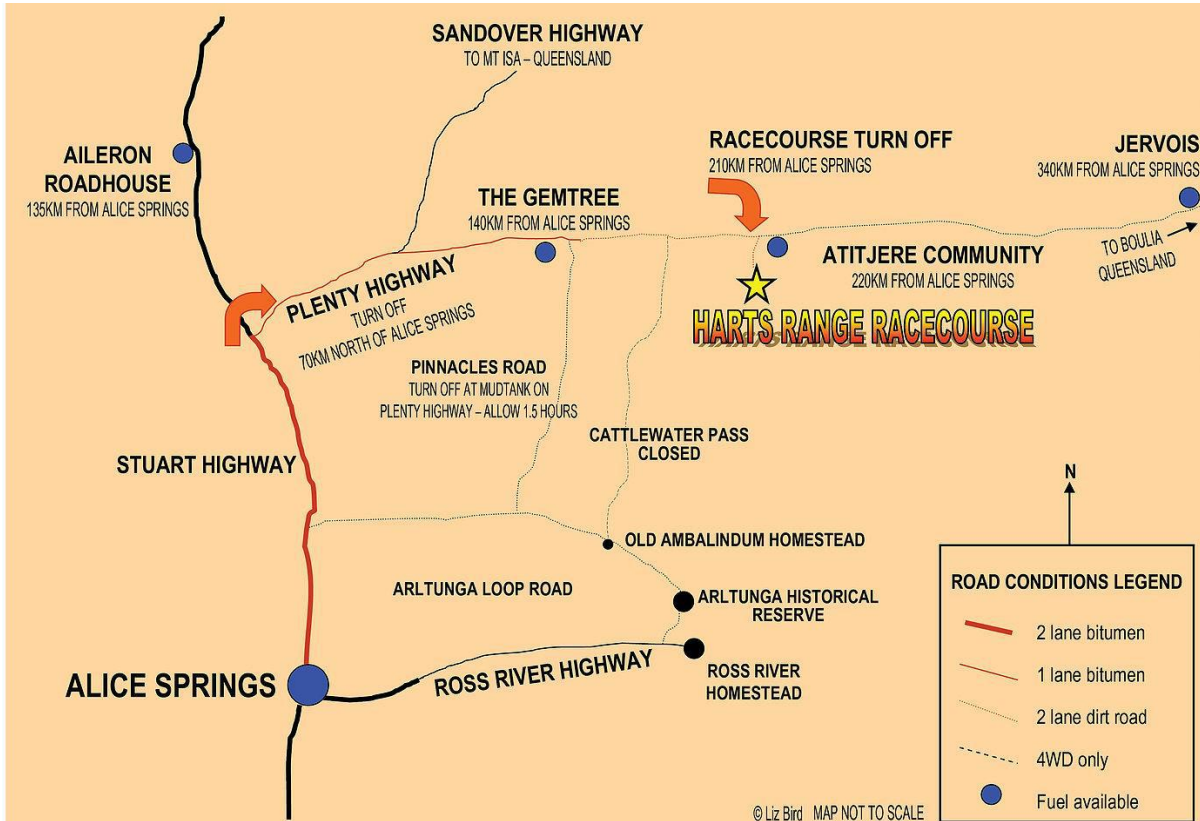
- Hat

- Suitable shoes and clothing to participate in Sports Events
- Camera
- Firewood

**Fuel:** Fuel is available at Gemtree, Harts Range and Mt Swan, but opening hours and availability vary.

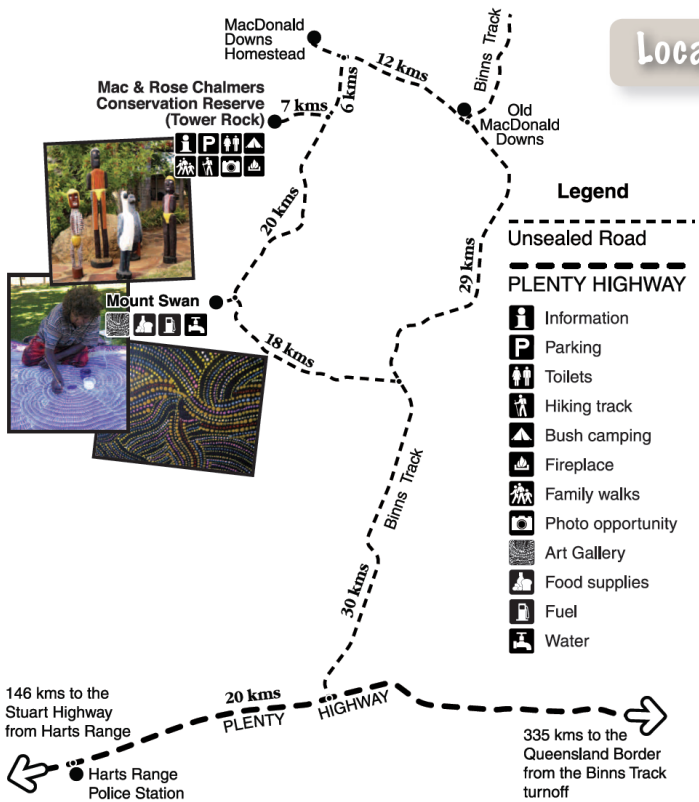
### In case of emergency:

- All vehicles will have personal details (medical) for each driver and passenger/s stored in envelopes in their vehicles glove box.
- The trip leader will travel with a SPOT tracker – if the SOS button is activated, the President of the Club will be sent a notification and emergency authorities will also be notified.
- If a member becomes injured and cannot be transported out, the trip leader will activate the 'help' button on the SPOT tracker or the SOS button depending on the severity of the injury.
- An 'ok' message will be sent to the Club President at the end of each day of travelling. This notification will provide the Club President with GPS coordinates of our location.
- Bushfires are unlikely given the sparse vegetation and the time of year we are travelling.
- There is no ATM or mobile phone coverage at Harts Range.

**Camping:** We will be camping the first night at the Harts Range Racecourse and the second night at Tower Rock. Members are welcome to stay on at the Harts Range Racecourse for the whole weekend, if it suits them.
