

How to sign up to Team App

Team App is the new way we communicate to our players, families and supporters at St. Ives AFL Club. Follow these instructions if you have never used Team App before and have not registered your details on Team App.

Note that you will not be able to purchase uniforms or tickets, or comment or like posts on Team App unless you are a registered user and Team App knows who you are.

Install the St Ives AFL Club App on your smartphone or tablet now!

Follow these steps:

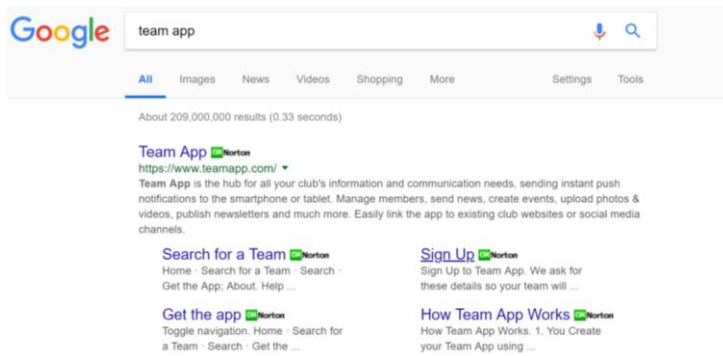
1. Download Team App from the Apple or Google Play app store.



2. Sign up to Team App. You will be sent an email to confirm your registration.
3. Log into the App and search for "St Ives AFL Club".
4. Choose your applicable access group(s).
5. If you don't have a smartphone go to www.stivesafl.com to sign up and view this App online.

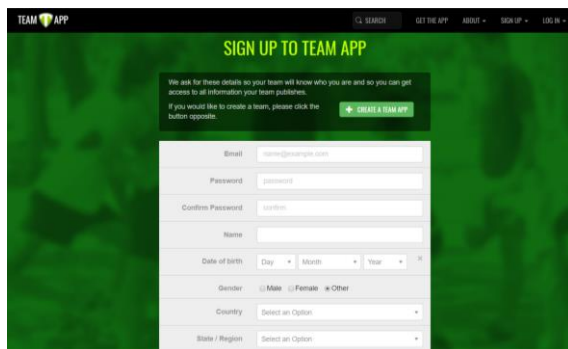


Step-by-step...Use your mobile device or desktop computer and search up 'Team App' in the App Store (on a tablet or smartphone) or search engine:

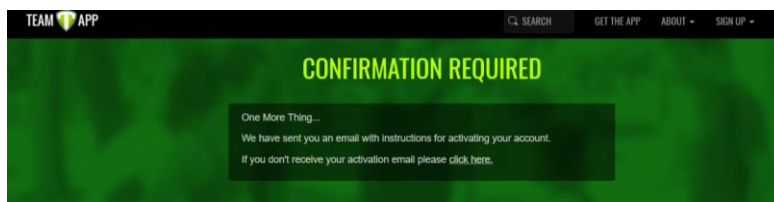


Click on 'Sign up' and enter your details (do not click on 'Create a Team App'):

Note that your password must be 8 characters or more. If your email address has previously been registered with Team App, you will get an error message asking you to log in. Do this by clicking on 'log in' on the top right corner and you can reset your password if you have forgotten it.



If there are no errors, you'll be asked to check your email to complete process:



Check your email to activate your Team App account. If you don't do this, your registration will not be complete.

Once you're signed up, log in to Team App and search for 'St Ives AFL Club'.

Request access to the group(s) that apply to you.

Check that you've turned on 'Notifications' for Team App in the Settings for your phone or tablet.

Then you'll be ready to receive communications from the Club!
